Science
Students will learn about identifying ways to change materials without changing their material composition. Year 1 students will not be assessed for this term in Science.

Maths
This term, students will carry out simple additions and subtractions using counting Strategies and partition numbers using place value. Students will order objects based on lengths and capacities using informal units. They will also classify outcomes of simple familiar events.

English
This term, students will look at different types of texts and making comparisons between them. They will also read short texts looking at different types of sentences, punctuation and using letter/sound relationships to support their reading.

Technologies
This semester, students in year one and two show how simple digital solutions meet a need for known users. Students represent and process data in different ways. They follow and describe basic algorithms involving a sequence of steps and branching. With assistance, students access and use digital systems for a purpose. They use the basic features of common digital tools to create, locate and share content, and to collaborate, following agreed behaviours. Students recognise that digital tools may store their personal data online.

Health and PE
Student will apply fundamental movement skills in different movement situations and explain how they move with objects and in space effectively.
