Science

This semester, students will Compare reversible changes, including dissolving and changes of state, and irreversible changes, including cooking, and rusting that produce new substances.

Maths

This term, students will connect fractions, decimals and percentages as different representations of the same number. They will locate fractions and integers on a number line and calculate a simple fraction of a quantity. They will also make connections between capacity and volume and solve problems involving length and area. Students will also describe probabilities using simple fractions, decimals and percentages.

English

Students will analyse, read two unfamiliar imaginative texts and explore text structures – running record and reading comprehension questions.

Students will write a letter to Member of Ipswich West, Jim Madden, to petition for new sports equipment or computer equipment. Plan an argument as to why these items are needed at our school. This may include; having this new equipment to benefit the students and what they will gain for using the items.
