

CURRICULUM PSHOT Term 2

English

Students engage with a variety of informative texts incorporating texts by First Nations Australian, Australian and world authors. These may include reports, reviews, procedures, biographies and autobiographies. Students explore content about a wide range of topics of interest or topics being studied in other curriculum areas.

They identify text structures and features including headings, timelines and images and how these inform the reader and improve access to the information in texts.

Students create a report to present to an audience.
