English

Students engage with a variety of informative texts with content of increasing complexity and technicality about topics of interest or topics being studied in other learning areas.

The range of texts, comprising writing by Australian, First Nations Australian, and wide-ranging world authors supports and extends independence in reading.

Students explore how texts such as factual descriptions, information reports, procedures and explanations are typically structured and presented relevant to purpose. Students examine how language features and images extend meaning. Students use these texts as models to create their own report to present to an audience.



Maths

Prime Maths is a world class program based on top-performing schools in Singapore, Republic of Korea and Hong Kong. The program covers the six strands of mathematics: Number, Algebra, Measurement, Space, Statistics and Probability. It is aligned to the Australian Curriculum: Mathematics Version 9.



Science

Biological Sciences: Australian Rainforests and living things

Students will classify and compare living and non-living things and investigate different lifecycles.
