This funding will be used to

- Review and implement whole school curriculum framework to ensure the systematic curriculum delivery of the 8 learning areas.
- Increase the number of Prep students exiting the end of year with a PM 5 or better.
- Ensure every student in Years 3 and 5 achieving NAPLAN national minimum standards across all areas – reading, numeracy, language conventions and writing.

Our initiatives include

- Build teacher capability in gathering and using evidence to determine and provide a differentiated curriculum for every student.
- Effectively use short cycle data to inform teaching and learning – specifically focussed on formative assessment and feedback to students.
- Personalise learning for each student with learning goals in Reading and Writing.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Allocate TRS to support SIMs (Student Improvement Meetings) to enable teaching staff to have professional conversations and build capacity around data literacy to inform teaching practice and student learning.	\$28 800
The purchase of LLI (Levelled Literacy Intervention) as a research-based literacy intervention program to provide explicit instruction in the teaching of reading.	\$18 000
Allocate time and resources to allow additional teacher assistant hours to provide targeted literacy intervention in the early years.	\$50 023
