This funding will be used to

- Implement whole school curriculum framework to ensure the systematic curriculum delivery of the eight learning areas.
- Implement P-2 Systematic Synthetics Phonics Instruction and 2-6 Spelling Mastery to increase literacy outcomes across the school.
- Improve Early Start data in Prep -2 and student outcomes in A-E for English across all year levels.

Our initiatives include

- Build teacher capability in data literacy and use of the Literacy Continuum
- Implement Spelling Mastery direct instruction in Years 2-6
- Personalise learning for each student with learning goals in Reading and Writing.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Allocate TRS to support SIMs (Student Improvement Meetings) and teacher planning days to enable teaching staff to have professional conversations and build capacity around data literacy to inform teaching practice and improve student achievement in A-E	\$25 000
The purchase of decodable readers for early years literacy instruction to provide systematic synthetic phonics instruction in the teaching of reading, spelling and writing.	\$14 468
Allocate time and resources to allow additional teacher assistant hours to provide targeted explicit intervention across the school for reading instruction.	\$50 000
